PAPER favorite **Aurel Schmidt** has been hanging in the Springs (where **Jackson Pollock** and **Lee Krasner** painted their abstract masterpieces) and her show "Summer Bummer," presented by The Fireplace Project, opens this weekend in Easthampton. 27-year-old Canadian Schmidt, who was in the 2010 Whitney Biennial, is known for using street debris imagery like cigarette butts and beer cans in her often erotic, yet disturbingly beautiful, intricately drawn pieces.
